

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All events organized by the association (1901 Act.) « Les Gendarmes et les Voleurs de Temps » and the National Gendarmerie (Gendarmerie of the region of Limousin, co-organizer).

These sporting events 100% nature in the countryside of the Monts d'Ambazac and Val du Taurion (Haute-Vienne), take place the weekend of Pentecost, the 19th and 20th of May , 2018.

Of these, two exceptional events:

- “Le Grand Trail du Limousin” : 52km, approved by the French Federation of Athletics (FFA)
- “Le Trail Les Voleurs de Temps » : 32km
 - ♦Internationally approved FFA
 - ♦Tour Trail National 2018.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Article 1 : The organization of the events (reception, departures, arrivals, showers - see website - WCs, changing rooms, podiums, partner village, entertainment, etc ...) is situated at the Estate of Muret in Ambazac (87).

Article 2 : Departure times

➤ Saturday 19 May 2018

- Canitrail 12km : Départ 9h00 (limité à 300 personnes) (new race)
- « Trail des Hureaux » 20km » : Departure at 14h30 (limited to 600 persons)
- *Childrens race*: departure at 15h30
 - ✓ “Poussins”: 0,800km (limited to 30 boys and 30 girls)
 - ✓ “Benjamins”: 1,200km (limited to 30 boys and 30 girls)
 - ✓ “Minimes”: 2km (limited to 30 boys and 30 girls)
- Ladies free style race "The Time Thieves": 5km - Non classifying - untimed - medical certificate mandatory- registered with bib number (first name + name) without chip - Departure at 17h30 (limited to 300 persons)

➤ Sunday 20th May 2018

- Trail «Les Voleurs de Temps »: 32km, departure at 8h00 (limited to 2000 inscriptions)
- « Le Grand Trail du Limousin »: 52km, departure at 8h30 (limited to 1000 inscriptions)

Article 3: Age limitations (age on the day of the race) birthdays between 1st January and 31st December 2018

- « Grand Trail du Limousin » 52km: born before or during 1998
- Trail « Les Voleurs de Temps » 32km: born before or during 1998
- “Trail des Hureaux” 20km: born before or during 2000
- Canitrail 12km : born before or during 2000
- *Discovery trail 11km*: born before or during 2002
- Ladies event « Les Voleuses de Temps » 5km: born before or during 2004
- Children’s race:
 - “Poussins” : born before or during 2007 et 2008
 - “Benjamins” : born before or during 2005 et 2006
 - “Minimes” : born before or during 2003 et 2004
- *Hiking events* 11km and 14,5km: Parental authorization is necessary for minors.

Article 4: Acceptance of the rules and regulations

The participation in the races “Gendarmes et Voleurs de Temps” implicates the express acceptance by each competitor of the rules, regulations and ethics published by the organization. It also implicates the acceptance to possess the required security materiel.

Each registered person undertakes to confine their passage to the paths marked by the organization. Cutting a path causes an irreversible erosion of the site and degrades in the long term. Failure to follow these instructions will result in disqualification.

Dustbins are placed in large numbers on each refreshment area and must be used for selective waste sorting.

Any runner caught knowingly throwing rubbish on the course will be disqualified.

In accordance with the charter “Natura 2000” concerning the environment, plastic cups will no longer be proposed at the refreshment areas.

Respect the environment

Article 5: Medical certificates and licenses

In accordance with the 2017-2018 regulations of manifestations “hors stade” issued by the “Federation Française d’Athlétisme”, all participation in the events are subject to the mandatory presentation by the participants of a medical certificate or license, valid at the date of the event.

Accepted documents:

- ✓ Licence Athlé Compétition, Athlé entreprise, Athlé Running ou Pass’Running issued by the Fédération Française d’Athlétisme. (Attention, the other licenses issued by the FFA - “Santé”, “Dirigeant” and “Découverte” will not be accepted).

- ✓ Sports License issued by an approved Federation on which must be expressly stated the approval of the practice of athletic or running competitions, valid at the date of the competition.

- ✓ License of competition issued by FFCO, FFPM or the FF Tri, valid at the date of the competition.

- ✓ Medical certificate (original or photo-copy) on which must be expressly stated the approval of the practice of athletic or running competitions. This document will be conserved by the organizer as justification in case of accident for a delay of 10 years. No other document will be accepted to attest the possession of the medical certificate.

Special case for foreign runners: Foreign participants must provide a medical certificate on which is expressly stated the approval of the practice of athletic or running competitions even if they hold a competition license issued by a federation affiliated to the IAAF.

This certificate must be written in French, dated, signed, and must enable the authentication of the doctor, whether the latter is established in this country or not. If it is not written in French, a French translation must be provided.

Article 6: Cancellation Guarantee Registration

Any person may, at the time of registration, subscribe to the cancellation guarantee. This fee will be added onto the entry fee at the time of payment. (Please note, the requests for reimbursement will be treated after the race and a franchise of 10% will be applied by the insurance company on each reimbursement).

Any commitment is firm and final. No reimbursement is possible under any circumstances unless the cancellation insurance has been subscribed at the moment of registration.

Each subscription is personal and cannot, under any circumstances, be transferred to another person.

Anyone retroceding his bib number to a third party will be held responsible for any accident or incident caused by the latter during the race. Anyone with a bib number acquired in breach of this regulation will be disqualified. The bib number must be entirely visible during the race. The organization declines all liability in case of accident in this type of situation.

Article 9: Collecting your bib number

Participation in the events requires wearing a bib number fixed on the chest by four safety pins. It shall in no case be made smaller, cut or folded under penalty of disqualification.

The bibs can be collected at the "Domaine de Muret" in Ambazac (87):

- For the Canitrail 12km : Saturday 19 May from 7h00 (see the plan on our site).
- For the other races : Saturday 19 May from 10h00 until 19h00 and Sunday 20 May from 6h30 until 16h, **upon individual presentation of identification. No collection can be made by a person on behalf of a group or on behalf of a third party.**

Article 10: Registration Changes

▫ Change from one race to another with lower mileage (or a hike): no refund.

▫ Change from one hike or race to another with higher mileage: the difference between the prices of the two races should be acquitted by the runner before the race.

▫ The registration changes are possible **until 6 May, 2018.**

Article 11: Cancellation of registration (if you have subscribed the cancellation insurance)

In case of a registration cancellation request, please find below the procedure to follow.

To declare your insurance claim, 2 steps to follow within 5 working days:

▫ First notify the race organizer

▫ Then you connect to the Global Assistance site at <https://indemnisation.mondial-assistance.fr/oss/> and follow the procedure. You will indicate the contract number to which your membership is related. Contract No. 303966.

Please note, the requests for reimbursement will be treated after the race and a franchise of 10% will be applied by the insurance company on each reimbursement.

No refund can be claimed in case of failure to submit a valid medical certificate.

Article 12: Classification and Diplomas

For all competitors for the 52km, 32km, 20km and 11km, Canitrail 12km; the classification and diplomas may be viewed and downloaded on the Internet.

Article 13: Publication of the results

The results will be displayed and contestable within a delay of 30 minutes as from the official FFA notification.

Afterwards, the results will be published on the Internet site of the race <http://www.gendarmes-et-voleurs.com/> and on that of the FFA

Article 14 : Reward and Podiums

A T-shirt is offered to competitors (except children's race and hiking races).

Only the competitors present at the award ceremony will be eligible for rewards:

- **"Le Grand Trail du Limousin" 52km:** scratch classification Trophies for top 3 men, 3 women and 3 first winners of each category V1.V2.V3.V4 and for the 1st "most promising male runner" and 1st "most promising female runner".
- **Trail " *Les Voleurs de Temps* " 32km:** scratch classification Trophies for the first 3 men and first 3 women and 3 winners of each category V1.V2.V3.V4 and for the 1st "most promising male runner" and 1st "most promising female runner".
- **"Trail des Hureaux" 20km** scratch classification Trophies for top 3 men, 3 women and 3 first winners of each category V1.V2.V3.V4. For the 1st "most promising male runner", 1st "most promising female runner" and for the 1st "most promising junior male runner", 1st "most promising junior female runner"
- **Discovery Trail 11km:** Trophies for the first 3 men and 3 women first from scratch. For the 1st "most promising male runner", 1st "most promising female runner" and for the 1st "most promising junior male runner", 1st "most promising junior female runner"
- **Canitrail 12km:** the first 3 tandems men and first 3 tandems women
- **Children's Races:** Podium for the first 3 in each category.

- **No accumulation:** A competitor that could cumulate 2 podiums (for example 32km scratch ranking and first V1) will be given an award only for the most prestigious title (in this example: the scratch).

Awards "rankings by team" (clubs FFA)

- Two rankings per team (club FFA):
- 1st team 52 km: 5 first arrivals of the same team, men or women, junior, seniors or veterans,
- 1st team 32 km: 5 first arrivals, men or women, junior, seniors or veterans.
- 1st team 20 km: 5 first arrivals, men or women, junior, seniors or veterans.

Article 15: Schedules Podiums

Saturday

- Canitrail : at the issue of the race (around 11h)
- Children's Races: at the end of the adult races.
- "Trail des Hureaux" 20km: at 17h30

Sunday

- Trail " *Les Voleurs de Temps* " 32km: at 14h30 for all categories.
- "Le Grand Trail du Limousin" 52km: at 17h30 for all categories.
- Canitrail 12km:
- Discovery Trail 10km: Following the event for the first 3 men and women of the scratch

Article 16: Modification of the course or the starting times, cancellation of the event.

Any modifications in the running of the Event will not give any right to refunds for any reason whatsoever. Any emergency decision will be made by a jury including at least the President of the host association, the vice president of the association, the race director, the person responsible for the course, the co-organizer "Region de Gendarmerie du Limousin", the coordinator responsible for medical safety, and the officials of the French Athletics Federation.

Article 17: Reconnaissance of the 5km - 11 km - Canitrail 12km - 20 km - 32 km - 52 km courses

Any reconnaissance of the courses before the race is prohibited, as each of these courses run through private properties. Nevertheless, it is still possible for the runner to get an overview of the course by taking the marked paths set up by the municipalities.

Article 18: Physiotherapists, osteopaths and Chiropodists

Physiotherapists, osteopaths and podiatrists will be on site to provide assistance to runners after their arrival.

Opening of the post: the access to this service and the type of care given is left to the discretion of the nursing staff, and also depends on the affluence at the time.

Article 19: Abandonment and Repatriation

Except for injury, a runner must not retire from the race except at a refreshment point. He must inform the person responsible for the area, who will then recover the bib and chip.

A shuttle service will be available to repatriate runners who have dropped out.

Runners who abandon at another help-point and whose state of health does not require evacuation must return as soon as possible, and by their own means, to the closest repatriation point.

In case of unfavorable weather conditions justifying a partial or total discontinuation of the race, the organization ensures the repatriation of the runners as soon as is possible.

In case of abandon of the race and turning back before reaching a refreshment point, the bib number and chip will be recovered by the file closers who will also inform the race PC.

As such, the runner will no longer be under the control and the responsibility of the organization. He must however inform the race PC of his safe return.

The telephone number of the help-point will be noted on the back of each bib number.

Any competitor that refuses to abandon and to be repatriated by bus to the starting area, on the advice of the doctors or the signalers, will be left to his own devices and must conform to the highway code.

Article 20: Insurance

- Liability: In accordance to current legislation, the organizers have taken out insurance covering the consequences of their civil responsibility, that of their employees and of all participants in the events organized by the “**Gendarmes et Voleurs de Temps**”.
- Licensees benefit from the guarantees granted by the insurance linked to their license. The other participants must be covered by their own personal insurance.
- Damages: The organizer disclaims all responsibility for any damage (theft, breakage, loss...) suffered by the personal property of the participants, even if they are under the care of the organizer. Participants will therefore not take action against the organizer for any damage to their equipment. The subscription of insurance covering these risks must be taken by the person participating.

Article 21: Chip card, Timing and live monitoring

Timing will be done under the control of representatives of the FFA Club and from the club KM42

The timing chip will be integrated into the bib of each runner.

The number must be placed as stipulated in the technical instructions. The runner cannot be timed in the following cases:

- Absence and / or loss of the bib
- Degradation of the bib
- An improper placing of the bib.

The participants can be followed on line on a mobile telephone application which can be downloaded from a smartphone or computer.

Article 22: Security and Medical Assistance

- The safety of the races is covered by the Police (Traffic Police and circuit markers)
- Medical assistance is provided by the Civil Protection and emergency doctors, rescue workers, 1 helicopter.

A first aid station is located at each refreshment point. These positions are equipped with telephone connections with the PC of the race. A medical team is present throughout the duration of the race.

Emergency stations are intended to provide assistance to any person in danger within the means of the organization or its employees. The official doctors are authorized to disqualify (by invalidating the race number) any competitor unfit to continue the event. Rescuers are authorized to evacuate by any means they see fit the runners that they consider in danger.

If necessary, and in the interest of the person rescued, the fire brigade will be called and the operations manager will implement all means appropriate and necessary at this time. The resulting costs of the use of these exceptional means will be borne by the rescued person who will also assure by his own means, his return from the point where he has been evacuated. He will then present a file to his personal accident insurance.

Any runner calling a doctor or a rescuer submits to their authority and undertakes to accept their decisions.

Article 23: Official Jury

The Official Jury consists of a referee of the FFA, whose decision is final. He is assisted by judges and race commissioners also appointed by the FFA.

Article 24: Accompaniment

No accompaniment or unaccredited vehicle (including bikes) will be allowed on the course.

Article 25: Doping Control

All competitors may be subject to doping control during or at the finish of the races. The refusal to comply results in immediate disqualification. Any positive test will result in lifetime ban for events organized by the association " Les Gendarmes et les Voleurs de Temps ».

The runners will receive their awards at the issue of the negative results for doping.

Article 26: Disqualification

Controllers on the course may check compliance with the Regulation (identity of the runners, respect of the various sites, ethics, illicit assistance or accompaniment, bib number not visible in the correct place ...).

The controller informs his chief and / or race PC and may, depending on the severity of the act and the behavior of the runner, decide that he be disqualified from competing. The trial jury may disqualify a competitor for any serious breach of the rules, particularly in case of:

- Bib Number not visible at all times: The bib must be attached to the chest and must be entirely visible during the whole duration of the race.
- Each runner must present identification documents when requested and if he refuses to do so or if the identification does not correspond to the one on the bib then he may be disqualified
- Non-compliance of the highway code on the parts of the course that are on public roads
- Non-compliance with safety instructions given by the checkpoint.
- Use of a means of transport
- Departure from a refreshment point after the deadline.
- Non-assistance to a runner in difficulty
- Personal assistance outside the official refreshment points
- Non-compliance with the ban to be accompanied on the course
- Pollution or degradation of sites by the competitor or a member of his entourage
- Insults, rudeness or threats made against any member of the organization and any volunteer

- Refusal to be examined by a doctor of the organization at any time of the event
- Doping or refusal to submit to doping control.

Article 27: Access and security of the site

Any objects that are susceptible to be dangerous or illegal, notably drugs, firearms, blunt weapons or explosives are strictly forbidden at the event location.

To access the site of the Event and participate in the races, the participant expressly accepts that the Organiser can call on security personnel who will be authorized to control the people as well as their personal belongings. Any person wishing access to the site accepts these controls. In case of refusal the person will not be allowed access to the site.

The Organiser as well as his security personnel have the right to refuse the access or the continuation of the race to any participant whose behavior is susceptible to perturb the smooth progress of the event, such as: introduction of any object that could bother the race in any way or the circulation and or the security of the other participants, any distinctive signs that may promote a political, philosophic or religious opinion that could harm the image of the Event.

Article 28: Use of images

"I expressly authorize the organizers of " Les Gendarmes et les Voleurs de Temps " and their entitled persons such as partners and media, to use images or videos on which I could appear, taken during my participation in the races organized by " Les Gendarmes et les Voleurs de Temps " on any media including promotional materials and / or advertising, in the world and for the longest duration allowed by law, regulations, treaties, including any extensions that could be made to this duration".

Article 29: CNIL

In accordance with the "Data Protection and Civil liberties law" from 6 January 1978, you have a right to access and correct your personal data. Through us, you may receive proposals from other companies or associations. If you do not want to receive these proposals, simply write to us stating your full name, address and race number.

Article 30: Use of drones

Participants are informed that:

- On the day of the event, driven tele aircraft (drones) may be used for filming,
- They may be located, during all or part of their participation in the event, within 30 meters of such aircraft.
- Certain zones previously defined and identified by the operator and identifiable with panels, barrier tape, and to which access is forbidden to the public as the participants, will be implemented by the operator to permit a landing in case of flight incident.

Article 31: Club Technical support.

The club KM42 is the technical support club for « Les Gendarmes et Voleurs de Temps ». They are affiliated to the « Federation Française d'Athlétisme » and their address is: 16 Route du Colombier, 87590 St-Just-Le-Martel.

The predominantly vertical signs will be completed with a few markings and safety tape on the ground. The dominant color is **RED**. Mileage is indicated every Km up to 5km then every 10km and finally, the last km.

Article 2: Time control mat

- Km 20,5 at “VIEUX”
- Km 23,85 at “LES BARRYS”
- Upon arrival.

Article 3: Disqualification

- Non-compliance with the rules of the race
- Leaving rubbish outside of the refreshment areas

- The minimum speed is of 6km / hour (10min to run 1km). A runner from the organization will participate in the race at 6km / hour. All runners that he will overtake must stop at the next checkpoint. - A retractable cup, flask or other ecological cup

A check will be conducted at the departure on randomly selected competitors. It can also be performed at any point of the course by accredited members of the organization. Refusal will result in an immediate exclusion.

ASCENT 221 m

Article 1 : Signalisation

The predominantly vertical signs will be completed with a few markings and safety tape on the ground. The dominant color is **NAVY BLUE**.

Article 2: The use of walking sticks

The use of walking sticks is prohibited.

Article 3: Disqualification

- Non-compliance with the course
- Leaving rubbish outside of the refreshment areas
- Use of prohibited walking sticks outside of the permitted areas.

The minimum speed is 6km / hour (10min to run 1km). A runner from the organization will participate in the race at 6km / hour. All runners that he will overtake must stop at the next checkpoint. They will be declared disqualified and **THE BIB NUMBER WILL BE REMOVED**. A vehicle will take them back to the site of Muret. In case of refusal from them and after informing the command post, they will be thereby disqualified and will no longer be under the responsibility of the Organization. The liability of the association shall in no case be engaged by any accident that may occur after this refusal.

Article 4 : Refreshment

- 1 liquid refreshment: water + glucose
- 1 refreshment will be provided in case of heat wave

Article 5: Mandatory equipment

A retractable cup, flask or other ecological cup

Article 6: Recommended equipment

- A water reserve
- A food reserve
- A mobile phone (please register the telephone number of the organization's security contact and make sure that this number will not be masked. Don't forget to keep the phone charged).
- A cap
- An identity card
- The individual Road-book provided by the organization.

ASCENT 276 m

Article 1: Signalisation

The predominantly vertical signs will be completed with a few markings and safety tape on the ground. The dominant color is **BLANC**.

Article 2: Disqualification

- Non-compliance with the rules of the race
- Leaving rubbish outside of the refreshment areas

The minimum speed is 6km / hour for a distance of 12k - maximum time is of 2h. A runner from the organization will participate in the race at 6km / hour. All runners that he will overtake must stop at the next checkpoint. They will be declared disqualified and **THE BIB NUMBER WILL BE REMOVED**. A vehicle will take them back to the site of Muret. In case of refusal from them and after informing the command post, they will be thereby disqualified and will no longer be under the responsibility of the Organization. The liability of the association shall in no case be engaged by any accident that may occur after this refusal.

Article 3 : Refreshment

- Liquid refreshment: water points for the dogs every 3km.
- For the runners: solid and liquid at km 6.

Article 4: Mandatory equipment

A retractable cup, flask or other ecological cup
For the dogs: see specific regulations here-after.

Article 6: Recommended equipment

ANNEXE

Regulations of the CANITRAIL

1. PREAMBLE

The canitrail event of the “Gendarmes et Voleurs de Temps” is organized in partnership with the CANIPAT'87 association and the Canine Sports and Leisure Federation (FSLC).

This regulation is an adaptation of the FSLC regulations, in agreement with the latter.

It comes in addition to the race rules of the other events of the “Gendarmes et Voleurs de Temps”.

2. STATUS OF RACE JUDGE

The canitrail of the “Gendarmes et Voleurs de Temps” being organized in partnership with the association CANIPAT'87 and the Federation of Canine Sports and Leisure (FSLC), the race will therefore be refereed by Judges Referees of the FSLC.

The lead judge will apply the penalties in force.

The rights of the race judge:

Participants must respect the decisions of the judge who has a delicate role.

Any insult to him cannot be tolerated and will be sanctioned.

The judge may impose certain constraints related to safety or refusal of departure of competitors sanctioned or having a bad ethics.

He can use all technical means to control the race (ex. camera, photo ...).

The decisions of the race judge are sovereign and cannot be challenged.

3. DOGS

3.1. Minimum age: All dogs, regardless of race and pedigree, are allowed to participate; **they must be at least 24 months old on the day of the event.**

Dogs of the first category are not admitted (respect of the laws in force).

3.2. Compulsory vaccinations: All dogs participating in the race must be vaccinated against rabies, parvovirus, distemper and kennel cough (bordetella parainfluenza virus, canine adenovirus2).

All dogs must be vaccinated within the last 12 months, except for rabies which, depending on the vaccine, may be valid for 1 or 3 years, but in all cases at least 21 days before the race in the case of primary vaccination.

If the race veterinarian strongly suspects a contagious disease on a dog present on the race site, this dog will have to leave immediately.

3.3. Identification: All dogs must be identified (chip, tattoo).

3.4. Sanitary veterinary control: The race veterinarian may request that a physical examination of the dogs be carried out before the start of the race, so that they may be allowed to run.

3.5. Dogs of 2nd category:

- Competitors participating in the event with second category dogs must at the same time submit their muzzle to the veterinarian's opinion and to the race judge who will validate its compliance with the use during the race.

- Any dog of the second category must conform to the legislation: meaning that his owner, at the time of his inscription, will have to present:

- The copy of the insurance certificate Civil Liability
- The detention permit
- The anti-rabies certificate and the up to date European vaccination certificate
- The muzzle as described in Appendix 1

- The Referee Judges of the Canin Sports and Leisure Federation may forbid the registration of the dog for a valid reason. The competitor concerned will be notified of the reasons for the ban.

3.6. Will not be allowed to participate on the day of the event, under veterinary control:

- Sick dogs, weakened or having a physical condition incompatible with the discipline.
- Pregnant or lactating bitches.
- Dogs with disabilities unless authorized by the veterinarian according to the handicap.

3.7. Replacement of the dog: In the event of an accident or incident occurring before a dog has taken the official start of the race in which it is registered, it may be replaced provided that the substitute corresponds to the rules enacted in the paragraphs above (veterinary control and age of the animal).

3.8. Bitches in heat will be able to participate in the race provided that they leave in delayed departure for the departures in line (behind the pack), and that the owners make use of a product to mask odors (to be signaled to the Race director).

3.9. Canine excrement

The runner has the obligation to pick up his dog's excrements.

4. THE COMPETITORS

4.1. Minimum age required: The runner must be at least 18 years old on the day of the event.

4.2. Dog owners:

- Is considered to be the legitimate owner of a dog, the one whose name appears on the identification card (CERFA No. 50-4447 issued by the Ministry of Agriculture and according to the directives of Decree No. 91 -823 of 28/08/91 controlled and managed by the Société Centrale Canine).

- He is obliged to ensure that the animal belonging to him is in conformity with the legislation in force according to his category, and must be able to justify it.

- The competitor is criminally liable for damage caused by the animal, even if it does not belong to him (Article 1385 of the Civil Code).

- It is advised to the owners to make sure that they are well covered by civil liability insurance for the damages that could commit their dog.

4.3. Licenses:

Federations' licenses are accepted: FSLC - FFST - - CNEAC with canicross option - FFPTC

5. START

The start will be grouped, but depending on the number of competitors, several waves can be put in place, according to the decision of the referee and the organizer.

The waves will be made according to the numbers of the bibs.

Group or wave start: all competitors will wait before the start line holding their dog by the collar or harness.

Participants may only appear on the starting line by order of the Referee or Starter.

6. CANITRAIL EQUIPMENT

6.1. Lanyard, harness, belt:

6.1.1. ARE PROHIBITED: the choke collar, the training collar (electrical) and the claw collar.

6.1.2. The use of cross shoes (with metal spikes) is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** in all circumstances.

6.1.3. The leash or lanyard with buffer of 2 meters maximum in extension is obligatory.

The measurement is at the level of the driver's waist to the base of the dog's tail.

6.1.4. The dog's harness is obligatory - See appendix 2

This traction harness should be comfortable so as not to injure the animal.

It should be adapted to its morphology, namely:

- it should not compress the rib cage or trachea
- nor hinder the movement of the shoulders
- All work-type harnesses and Norwegian-type harnesses are prohibited.
- The judge can refuse a harness conform if he considers that it is not adapted to the dog (too small, damaged ...)

6.1.5. The runner will also have to wear:

Either an abdominal belt with a width of at least 7 cm or a subcutaneous belt (harness type) or bib shorts with integrated belt.

6.1.6. All competitors must make sure that his equipment is in conformity with the preceding paragraphs so as to be able to take the departure.

6.1.7. All category 2 dogs are able to participate in the various events, provided they are muzzled.

It must be a muzzle that allows the dog to open the mouth, hang out the tongue, to pant, to drink, all whilst maintaining its safe function (see Appendix 1).

6.1.8. All dogs requiring a muzzle, (obligation for the category 2 dogs (cf 6.1.7), will be able to take the departure equipped with an adapted muzzle, that allows the dog to open the mouth, hang out the tongue, to pant, to drink and whose type is similar to models validated by the FSLC (see photos on Appendix 1).

6.2. Personal provisions:

Wearing a hydration system, such as a water bag or bottle, is mandatory.

Its capacity must be of at least 0.6 liters.

It is advisable to bring a soft bowl or other for the hydration of the dog.

7. CANITRAIL DISTANCE / TEMPERATURE / REFRESHMENT

The Canitrail event, the “Gendarmes et Voleurs de Temps” is of the “short canitrail” type, its distance is between 11 and 13 km

7.1. Temperatures:

- In case the temperature at the starting block should be higher than 20 ° C, the race referee and the organizer could decide to reduce the distance.

This reduction does not cancel the race and registration costs will not be refunded.

- Regardless of the race, temperature and humidity conditions, a registered competitor has the option of not running if he believes that his dog will not tolerate the heat. If the race is not officially canceled, registration fees will not be refunded.

The canitrailers will have to behave with the greatest vigilance regarding the variations of temperatures and not hesitate to walk if necessary, which in this case will not be penalized.

The risk of heat stroke may appear as soon as the temperature exceeds 15 ° C.

7.2. Water points for the dogs - Supply

A water point for the dogs will be available every 3 km.

The water point may be made from troughs, tubs or may be a natural water point on the course that is easily accessible.

For the runners, a refreshment point will be put in place around the halfway point.

8. ANIMAL RESPECT

8.1. Responsibility: All runners are responsible for the well-being of their dogs.

8.2. Abuse of dogs with or without an instrument is strictly prohibited.

If a competitor inflicts bad treatment on a dog, he will be disqualified. Failure to comply with these rules may be sanctioned by the race judge, either of his own initiative or at the request of the organizer.

8.3. Dog transport: the regulations of the Rural Code concerning the transport of domestic carnivores are fully applicable.

Failure to comply with these regulations may be sanctioned by the race judge, either of his own initiative or at the request of the organizer

8.4. Whenever possible, the dog's name will always be associated with that of the master.

At the awards ceremony, it is preferable that the dog be present.

9. ANTI DOPING - MEDICAL TREATMENTS OF DOGS AND HUMANS

The participants in the event, licensed or not, must respect scrupulously the regulations of the FSLC in the fight against doping and against the doping of the animals.

10. SANCTIONS

DURING THE RACE

10.1. The dog will be permanently attached to the runner by a lead with buffer unless, for security reasons, the organizer materializes a "FREEDOG" zone.

10.2. The dog must be permanently in front of his owner. The maximum limit allowed is for the runner to be at the height of the dog's shoulders, except in the case of a tricky descent.

It is strictly forbidden to pull the dog, except to put it back in the direction of the race (change of direction, evasion, inattention due to the immediate environment such as spectator's dog, crossing streams ...).

10.3. If a dog is no longer fit to run or refuses to advance for any reason, the runner is not allowed to finish the event.

10.4. Overtaking: Any rider may ask the competitor who precedes him to let him and his dog pass. To do so he must express the following words in a high and intelligible voice ("PISTE") or ("PISTE GAUCHE» for the left and (PISTE) or ("PISTE DROITE") for the right. On the order "PISTE", the competitor who is being overtaken and his dog must remain on the same side of the track. DROITE = I go past on the right, GAUCHE = I go past on the left.

The overtaken competitor cannot oppose and should facilitate this action and, if necessary, hold his dog by the collar or harness and shorten the lead so the other can pass him without hinder.

Failure to comply with this instruction will result in the penalties provided for in paragraph 11.

This rule does not apply for the last 300 meters of race.

10.5. Accompaniment: It is forbidden for a third person to run beside, behind or in front of the "tandem" to motivate the animal. The same applies with a cycle, a dog or a motorized machine.

10.6. Except for the persons designated as officials on the event, any person circulating on the side of the race must remain motionless whilst the competitors run past.

A competitor not respecting this obligation or disrupting the passage of other competitors will be penalized by one minute.

10.7. Reconnaissance of the race path: The times for looking round the race path, with or without dogs, will be defined by the organizer and will be at his discretion. For safety reasons, the race path must be freed from all competitors at least one hour before the race.

Failure to comply with the instructions entails a penalty under paragraph 11.

11. PENALTIES

11.1. It is forbidden to pull the dog: One minute penalty at the first offense. Exclusion at the second offense.

11.2. It is forbidden to run in front of the dog:

(Not applicable in the case of a tricky descent during which the animal may be behind his driver and provided that the lead is never tight).

A warning for the first offense then one minute penalty per additional offense.

11.3. It is forbidden to prevent the dog from drinking: One minute penalty at the first sighting. Disqualification at the second.

11.4. Non-respect of the rules of the race: Disqualification when the non-respect of the course is voluntary or that the error, due to negligence or inattention, brings a certain advantage compared to the other competitors.

11.5. It is forbidden to unleash your dog (apart from the delicate passages where permission to release the dog is indicated): One minute penalty.

11.6. Refusal to be overtaken: One minute to the first offense. Disqualification for the second.

11.7. Physical violence to the dog or a competitor: Disqualification.

11.8. Verbal or physical violence to the referee or a competitor: penalty depending on the seriousness of the facts up to and including disqualification.

11.9. Failure to comply with the organizer's instructions for reconnaissance of the race path: 1 minute penalty.

11.10. Category 2 dog not muzzled (or with a muzzle non-conform): the dog will not be able to take the start. Dog who arrives and / or is seen on the course without a muzzle or with a muzzle non-conform: disqualification.

11.11. Uncategorized dog muzzled with a classic material (muzzle nylon, leather, etc ...) beyond 400 meters after the start: Disqualification.

11.12. Dog bite: 1st offense: warning. 2nd offense: penalty 1 minute, obligation to wear a muzzle.

11.13. The wearing of an earpiece: One minute penalty.

11.14. The penalties are cumulative
